

# Call For Projects

## *Grant for Habitat Projects in Garfield County*

- Who:** Government agencies or organizations that are classified as a non-profit 501(c)3. Or private landowner that partners with a governmental agency or organization that are willing to represent them as a fiscal sponsor
- What:** Up to \$20,000 is available to fund habitat projects located in Garfield County
- When:** The Application deadline is Wednesday, March 1, 2017
- Why:** Puget Sound Energy Lower Snake River Wind Habitat Project Fund was established by Puget Sound Energy in connection with its wind power operations in Garfield County. The Purpose of the Fund is to help fund projects that serve the protect and enhance habitat in Garfield County
- Why:** A committee of local citizens, the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife, Garfield County, Puget Sound Energy and the Blue Mountain Community Foundation will select a project or projects to be funded by the grant funds
